Developing and Empowering the Leaders of Tomorrow Chris Lake • Head of Professional Development

Chris will lead an interactive session exploring what learning really is - not just the acquisition of knowledge and skills, but really developing as a leader and a person. You'll examine maps of learning, leadership, organisations - and the London Underground too! As you do this, you'll also explore your own maps: your assumptions about how people, organisations and the world works.

Towards a Leeds Health Economy Strategy Mike Chitty • Head of Applied Leadership and Operations

A chance to add your thoughts on strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats in the Leeds Health Economy and to contribute your thinking to how we might develop stronger leadership around it. The Academy has a strong track record of helping whole system leadership to develop in health economies, through our commissioned work, our Intersect programme and our significant contribution to Pioneer and Vanguard sites through England. As well as thinking about Leeds we will have Academy staff on hand with experience of our work in other areas to share what we have learned and to listen to what might be helpful in Leeds. A key part of our leadership work is to support work with the NHS, local Authorities and Third and private sector partners to work together on place based health leadership strategies. In this session we will give you the chance to contribute to a model of the Leeds Health Economy and develop your own perspective on what might contribute to strategy.

Not simply focusing upon the learning of new knowledge, the session will really help you challenge and develop your own leadership practice by encouraging you to engage with fellow participants. You'll have a chance to reflect upon what 'influencing' means, to consider and 'map' your own influencing styles and behaviours, and to explore how to develop and flex your influencing skills for even greater impact.





Board Development

The Academy has an incredible pool of talented and experienced Faculty who help to provide our Board Development Service. We have worked with a wide range of Boards in a wide range of contexts including Trusts that have been deemed 'not well lead' by CQC. We also have supported board to board dialogues to help consider how organisational reconfiguration or changes in partnership relationships or investing differently in services might help achieve the objectives of the Five Year Forward View. In this session we will take you through some of the models and processes that we use in our board development service, as well as talk about some more specialist services including executive coaching, pairs coaching and other approaches to board and executive director development.

Progress School

This will be a taster session to the Academy's own internal staff development programme 'Progress School'. These monthly development sessions provide coaching in a group session for Academy staff. Progress School runs for 2 hours every month and uses the Self Directed Leadership Development Model of Boyatzis, Goleman and McKee. In this session you will have the opportunity to experience this powerful approach to personal development and see how it can be used to develop your own leadership.
